THE ROLE

A pharmacy technician's role is to assist the pharmacist in the preparation of prescription medications, provide customer service, and perform administrative duties within a variety of practice settings, such as retail, long-term care and home infusion pharmacies. General responsibilities include receiving prescription requests, counting tablets, labeling bottles, maintaining patient profiles, preparing insurance claims, and performing administrative functions such as answering phones, stocking shelves, and operating cash registers.

Applicants must have a high school diploma and be at least 18 years old.
